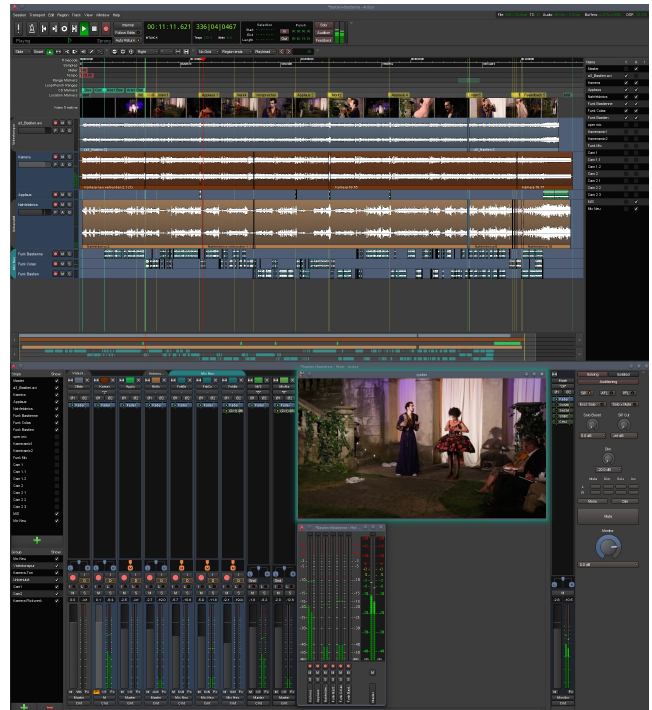


Feature Presentation: Ardour – audio software
